

Rule and Regulations of Society

1) Defination of words used in Regulation.

- Society means "Mauli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Aurangabad".
- Chairman Means Chairman of 'Mauli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Aurangabad'.
- Vice Chairman Means Vice Chairman of 'Mauli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Aurangabad'.
- Secretary means Secretary of 'Mauli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Aurangabad'.
- Treasurer Means Treasurer of 'Mauli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Aurangabad'.
- Executive Body member means executive body member of 'Mauli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Aurangabad'.
- Member means any member of 'Mauli Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Aurangabad'.

2) Jurisdiction :

Jurisdiction of society will be entire 'India'.

3) Accounting year :

Society's Accounting year will be 1st April to 31st March.

4) Member and Procedure for their registration.

Any Indian above the age of 18 can get membership. He has to apply for membership. After the application approved by executive body he has to pay required subscription to society then only he will be registered in the list of members of society.

5) **Type of Membership :**

Life Member : Paying Rs.501/- as annual Subscription to society. Will be treated as life member.

General Member : Paying Rs. 50/- annual membership subscription to society will be treated as general member.

6) **Cancellation of membership :**

Executive committee will cancel the membership of any member by passing resolution by majority if, any member, punished by court of law against illegal offences, non payment of contribution, dead, left the country and went to foreign, addicted, misbehaving, making loss to society.

7) **General body meeting, authority & responsibilities :**

General body meeting will be considered as last decision making body. This will be conducted once in a year. All types of members can participate. General body meeting authorise to control working of executive body, to sanction annual accounts, to approve next year financial budget, to change the rules as necessary, to select executive body members, to give decision on resolutions put in time.

8) **Notice of General body meeting and Crum :**

It is necessary to intimate date of General body Meeting to all members. The written notice will provide date, time, place and subjects. Notice can be collected by members by signing on Dak book of society, otherwise they may receiver it by Post before 15 days of meeting. If 1/3 of total members present for meeting it will be considered that corum is full.

If meeting is adjourned for want of corum, the adjourned meeting will have no restriction of corum but this will have to be recorded.

9) **Special General Body meeting and it's objective :**

This type of meeting can be conducted at any time if required. Functions executed by general body meeting can be done by special general body meeting.

10) **Appointment of executive body members and office bearers :**
Executive body will consist of minimum 7 and Maximum 13 members. Following officials will be included in body – Chairman –1, Vice Chairman-1, Secretary-1, Joint Secretary-1, Treasurer-1, others will be members of executive body.

11) **Period of executive body and type of election :**
Executive body's period will be 5 years. Type of election will be secret voting. Panel will be elected in general body meeting by meajority after every 5 years.

12) **Functions of executive body members :**

Chairman : Will accept chairmanship and execute the functioning of society, Control society's administration, issue orders for the benefit of society, issue notice to conduct meetings.

Vice Chairman : To function as chairman in absence of chairman otherwise to assist chairman for smooth functioning of society.

- Secretary :**
- 1) To conduct meetings of society.
 - 2) To subsidies complaints
 - 3) Keep eye on society's employees.
 - 4) To modify casual rules.
 - 5) To complete accessory court work for society.
 - 6) To complete annual accounts statement and put forth of general body meeting.
 - 7) To keep daily accounts and sign statements.
 - 8) To approve expenses bills.
 - 9) To execute passed resolutions.
 - 10) To handle the cash on behalf of society.
 - 11) To supervise estate of society.
 - 12) To do any work beneficial to society.

Jt. Secretary : To work as secretary in absence of secretary. In other times to assist secretary to perform job for society.

- Treasurer :**
- To control entire financial conditions.
 - To write accounts.
 - To submit completed accounts to executive body.
 - To prepare annual reports through account books.
 - To submit compliance to remove deficiencies pointed out by auditors.

Executive body members :

- To be present for executive body meeting and General Body Meeting.
- To vote in election and to assist in work for society.

Other Members :

- To present in General Body Meeting.
- To vote in election and to help in working of society.

13) Executive body meeting and a demand for meeting.

At least 3 executive body meetings will be conducted in a year. If any member demands for meeting, chairman or secretary has to call for executive body meeting within 15 days.

14) Executive body meeting notice and corum.

It is necessary to issue written notice of meeting before 2 days. Date, Place, time and subjects will be informed through notice. Notice will be issued by received signature in notice book or by post.

It will be understood that, if 2/3 of members present in meeting corum is full.

15) Rules for election of executive body :

Rules for election of executive body will be decided by general body meeting. Defolter member can not be a candidate for election and he will not have right to vote.

16) For filling vacant seat in executive body.

Executive body can fill vacant seat.

17) Powers a functions of executive body.

Executive body will control administration of society. Will execute the resolution passed in general body meeting to run smoothly working of society after casual rules or prepare casual rules and will change it required. If necessary will appoint subcommittee for any work. Will get information and accounts from subcommittee and desolve the subcommittee. Will approve to the branches of society / withdraw the approval.

Will complete all legal matters, control the expenses, to note the complaints, fill the vacancies in executive body, appoint the employees, removal of them. To do all essential work and execute passed resolution by majority & legally.

18) Societies Funds, Income and utilization :

Member ship fee, donation, aids, services, education, medical fees, Cash or any other form of donation, fixed assets or deposits will be source of income for society. Contributions can be collected and invested in estates. All this income will be recorded in public trust register by application.

19) Objective budget provision (%)

100% expenses can be incurred on those objectives for which amount has been collected. 50% amount can be incurred on the first 1 to 5 objectives & 50% amount can be incurred on remaining objectives.

20) Provisions for loan or deposits :

Loan / deposits can be accepted from any individual / Bank as per the requirements of society. For that society has to get proper mission from charity commissioner.

21) Provisions for purchase / sales of estate :

Society will have right to purchase/Sale estate. Society has to get consent from executive body by majority. If society intend to sell estate they will have to obtain permission from charity Commissioner.

22) Bank Accounts :

Balance amount with society can be deposit in any National Bank/ approved schedule Bank, in the name of Society out of 3 office bearers of – Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer any two of them can withdraw the amount by joint signature.

23) **System for listing the members.**

The list of members according to sections 15 of Society Registration Act 186, Will be kept in format mentioned in the serial no – 6 of 15 section of Maha Society Rules.

24) **Provision for Alteration in rules regulations.**



Further, in accordance of the regulation **59 (6)** of notified Regulations namely the "**Minimum essential standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Institutions Regulations, 2024**, a letter was sent to you vide letter of even no. **dated 25.11.2025** to furnish fixed security deposit worth **Rupees 02 Crores** for a period of five year in favor of National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine.
4. Thereafter, the assessment report and all other related documents were placed in the **154th Board Meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **26.11.2025** and Board decided to issue letter of Permission to establish a new Ayurveda Medical college with an **intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2025-26 after receiving Fixed security deposit amount of Rs 02 Crores.** In response of the same you have furnished the fixed security deposit amount in favor of the National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine through RTGS mode vide **UTR no. IBKLR92025112900037208 dated 29.11.2025 and informed the same vide an email dated 29.11.2025.**

"DECISION

5. Therefore, **In accordance with Regulation 63 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 , Letter of Permission (LoP) is issued to The President/Secretary, Mauli Shikshan Prasark Mandal, At Apegaon, Tal. Paithan Dist. Aurangabad-431137 Maharashtra to establish a new Ayurvedic Medical college in the name of Mauli Ayurved Medical College & Research Centre At Tondar, Tq, Udgir, Dist. Latur-413517, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-2025AYU0917) with an intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2025-26, under Section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder subject to the following conditions: -**
 1. It is further informed that **minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats shall be treated as all India quota.** The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counselling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

- II. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
 7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
 8. **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
 9. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2025 and compliance report should be submitted to MARBISM in order to be considered for the process of the permission for the academic session 2026-2027 as per rules:**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of minimum standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in MES (Assessment & Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
 10. The College administration shall ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the NCISM ACT and relevant regulation thereunder, are in position before the admission of the 1st batch of student in the 1st professional of BAMS is made, under intimation to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM.
 11. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
 12. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for I, II and III professionals well in time as per the norms which will be verified by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board and accordingly the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be considered.
 13. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 35 of the NCISM Act, 2020 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
 14. The fulfillment of the condition given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian system of medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian system of medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission matter for the academic session 2026-27.
