Subject:- Grant of 1st Renewal of Permission to Mauli Ayurved Medical College & Research Centre At Tondar, Tq, Udgir, Dist. Latur-413517, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0917) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27-reg.

Sir/Madam,

1. To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Mauli Ayurved Medical College & Research Centre At Tondar, Tq, Udgir, Dist. Latur-413517, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0917)** inspection was conducted on **11.05.2026 and 12.05.2026 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **1st renewal of permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27.**
2. The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder.
3. The assessment report was duly placed before the **166th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 28.07.2026 and Board concluded that:-**

"The college meets the notified & requisite approved criteria for the issuance of the 1st Renewal of permission. Hence, the Board decided to issue the 1st renewal of permission in accordance with Regulation 64 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024, with an intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2026-27".

"DECISION"

4. Therefore, **1st renewal of permission in accordance with Regulation 64 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 is hereby issued to Mauli Ayurved Medical College & Research Centre At Tondar, Tq, Udgir, Dist. Latur-413517, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0917) academic session 2026-27, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled: -**
 - I. It is informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2026-27 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
6. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

8. **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
9. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2026 and compliance report should be submitted to MARBISM in order to be considered for the process of the permission for the academic session 2027-2028 as per rules:**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
10. The College administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the NCISM ACT and relevant regulation thereunder, are in position before the admission of 2nd batch of students in the 1st professional BAMS is made under intimation to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM.
11. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for II and III professionals well in time in accordance with the Regulation (66) of MESAR 2024 which will be verified by the medical assessment and rating board and accordingly the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be considered.
12. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 35 of the NCISM Act, 2020 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
13. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the renewal of permission for the academic session 2027-28.
